General Information re: Trail Ride and SPHC Outdoor Trail Challenge

- Breakfast is available at Trails End and a concession is available for lunch both days.

- Tickets are available for the BBQ Steak/chicken supper on Saturday, June 30th to be purchased through Chris at Trails End (\$25 each). You can also purchase steak supper tickets from Chris up until 10 am on Saturday, June 30th.

SATURDAY – Trail Ride – leaves at 10 am sharp and will return by 12 noon

- SEE RIDE RULES ON RELEASE FORM.
- Helmets required for anyone under 18 years of age.
- PRE-REGISTER (must be received by June 20th) TO RIDE AT THE REDUCED RATE (\$20.00/rider) or \$40.00 for a family of 3+
- If not received by June 20th- \$25.00/rider or \$45.00 for family of 3+.
- Trail Ride will leave at 10 am SHARP.
- **REGISTRATION REQUIRES A COMPLETED TRAIL RIDE REGISTRATION FORM AND A RIDER RELEASE FORM FOR EACH RIDER IN YOUR PARTY, GROUP, OR FAMILY AS WELL AS PAYMENT**

Horsemanship Clinic with Deb Flegel – limit of 5 participants for each 2 hour clinic (entry form and payment required to guarantee a spot). If enough participants we will add a Saturday morning clinic during the trail ride.

Trail Obstacle Practice – Horse/Human Broom Ball are simply fun events available Saturday afternoon – or you and your horse can enjoy the swimming hole!

Team Challenge at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday June 30th

Entries close at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 30th (must be handed in to Ronni Nordal). Payment (\$10/entry) required at time of entry. 2 person teams drawn from the hat. You can enter to compete as many times as you like. Teams will be drawn at the Steak Supper. Awards to 4th place.

SUNDAY - Outdoor Trail Challenge

You can pre-enter at a reduced rate (\$25.00/division) until June 20. Entries not received by June 20th at \$30.00 division. No entries accepted after 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 1st.

- 9:00 a.m. Challenge begins. Helmets are required for exhibitors under 18 years of age and under.
- The Outdoor challenge is open to all breeds of horses and all ages of riders. Obstacles are designed to replicate those that you may encounter on a trail. There may be obstacles such as a water crossings, hills, deadfall, carry/move an object, back, side pass, jog, lope (both leads), drag an object, trailer load etc. Each obstacle will be judged and scored on the horse's attitude, willingness, and ability to complete all obstacles correctly and efficiently. Time may only be a factor in Men's or Women's divisions.
- An honest attempt at an obstacle is better than skipping the obstacle, but completion of the obstacle will score higher. Failing to attempt/complete an obstacle will not cause you to be disqualified, but you will be scored accordingly.
- You can enter multiple horses/same rider or different rider. Substitutions of horse or rider allowed but NO substitutions once class has begun.
- Patterns for all divisions will be handed out to paid entries on Saturday evening or upon payment and exhibitors will be allowed to walk the course (without horse) at 8:30 a.m. on Sunday.

When completing entries & reservations be sure to include

- Release form signed by each member or guardian for each rider
- Entry form, copy of registration papers to qualify for hi point paint (if applicable) – all fees must be paid before entry accepted.
