Office fee: \$60/horse

Haul In Fee: \$20/horse

Leadline: \$10.00 flat fee

Class fee: \$15/horse/judge (\$60/class) – OR -

SPHC Member All Inclusive Fee: \$350.00 per horse (includes office fee). Horse can then be entered in any classes in any division, with any exhibitor

Any NSF Cheques will receive a \$35 NSF charge.

SPHC membership required to qualify for SPHC All Inclusive Fee, for division hi point awards and to enter jackpots

Paid Warmup classes are \$10 per class and to be **paid at the show office!**

Jackpot Rules:

1111 Showmanship: \$10 entry. All entry fees paid out to 4th (no added money). Enter on Class form.

Open to Youth, Amateur/Non Pro and Trainers/Pros

Remaining Jackpots 1000 to 6000

- must enter one class (any class) (office fee applies)
- must be a SPHC member to enter
- Jackpot Entries and payment due 7pm Friday, May 25, 2019 No late entries accepted.
- \$60 entry fee (\$10 to SPHC)
- added money of \$250 to each jackpot (\$125 if 2 entries/\$50 if 1 entry)

Payout structure:

1 -2 entries (90%/10%)

1- 3 entries (75%/25%)

4 - 6 entries (60%/25%/15%)

7 & over entries (50%/25%/15%/10%)

- payout to horse owner indicated on entry form
- No refunds but substitutions allowed
- all final decisions determined by Show Committee

Trailer Parking/Power: There is NO power available at the Prairieland Park arena facility. The Prairieland Park Campground is available between the barns and Sports on Tap - to be arranged for, and paid, directly to Prairieland Park. If you do not need power/have your own generator, you can park on the sand by the outdoor ring (room must be left for tractor to get into outdoor arena) and there will not be any charge. *NOTE: NO PARKING ON PAVED LOT and NO RUNNING CORDS TO ARENA*

IT IS THE EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR ANY DIVISION AND TO ENTER THE CORRECT CLASS(ES) AND DIVISION(S).

2 Year Olds that are shown under saddle are no longer eligible to be shown in APHA 2 Yr longe-line.

APHA has specific rules regarding Ranch Riding including that horses are not eligible to cross over between Ranch Riding and Western Pleasure
