- There are 12 pens available for horses on a first come first paid bases. You can set up individual pens and or electric fencing as well.

There will be organized trail rides, games, and fun activities for the entire family.

We will have a fun, natural trail course challenge on the Sunday for all those that are wanting to participate.

We will be having our Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club Youth Scholarship speeches held on the night of June 22. Any youth with a registered Paint Horse is eligible for this scholarship. Please see our website for details.

Grasswood Horse Park Rules

- This park is for horse and pedestrian traffic only.
- **No dogs permitted on park site.**
- No kites, Frisbees or airborne objects.
- Riders and parents/legal guardian (if minor) will assume all responsibility when on the Grasswood Horse Park grounds
- Children must be supervised by an adult.
- Approved ASTM/SEI helmet mandatory for riders/handlers age 18 and under (at all times when mounted, driving a horse drawn vehicle or handling a horse).
- Boots with a heel are mandatory for riding
- No motorized traffic permitted outside of parking area (vehicles, snowmobiles, motorbikes, ATVs, etc.) except maintenance and delivery vehicles.
- Vehicles and trailers restricted to designated parking area.
- Tie horses to designated hitching fixtures only.
- Do not leave horses unattended.
- Beware of natural hazards (gopher and badger holes) and wildlife.
- Horse owners responsible for damage caused by horses.
- Advise CPHRA of incidents or damage to property by completing an Incident/Damage Report (available online). **Arena Rules-**In addition to the Grasswood Horse Park Rules **Trail Course Rules-** In addition to the Grasswood Horse

Close gate behind you at all times. Park Rules

- Riders/handlers/coaches only allowed in arena.
- Do not tie horses to arena fence.
- Announce intentions to others: e.g. "Door" to enter/exit, "Passing".
- Keep a horse length between.
- Mount off the track and do not loiter on the track.

- Ride on left when meeting oncoming
- Call "Heads up!" if horse is loose or out of control.

- Slow to the inside, fast to the
- Stop and dismount in emergency (loose horse, rider down).
- Ask before lunging.
- Be aware and courteous of green horses, new riders and situations that may spook horses.

- Work together and give right-of-way when needed. No loose horses in arena.

Orientation and training required for access to challenge/obstacle courses

Remember :

- If you feel an obstacle is beyond the abilities of you and/or your horse please avoid that obstacles.
- No running, rolling or pawing in the pond
- No riding double, or riding with a loose foal
- No motorized vehicles on the Course, except emergency or maintenance vehicles
- Please notify CPHRA of any damages or unsafe obstacles immediately
