

Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club- 2025 Breeders' Awards Rules

1. **Categories**

- 1.1. Breeder of the Year
- 1.2. Sire of the Year
- 1.3. Horse of the Year

2. **Breeder of the Year**

- 2.1. To qualify, the Breeder must be:
 - 2.1.1. a current Saskatchewan resident
 - 2.1.2. a current member in good standing of the SPHC & APHA
- 2.2. Points will count for:
 - 2.2.1. horses on which the Breeder appears on the APHA papers AND
 - 2.2.2. the place of birth on the papers is in Saskatchewan
- 2.3. Points will be calculated as follows for each eligible horse:
 - 2.3.1. Attending an SPHC show will be worth 3pt
 - 2.3.2. Attending an SPHC event will be worth 1pt
 - 2.3.3. Points for each class (see section 5 for Point Calculations)

3. **Sire of the Year**

- 3.1. The stallion owner must:
 - 3.1.1. be a current Saskatchewan resident
 - 3.1.2. be a current member in good standing of the SPHC
- 3.2. Points will count for:
 - 3.2.1. Any foals sired by the stallion
- 3.3. Points will be calculated as follows for each eligible offspring:
 - 3.3.1. Attending an SPHC show will be worth 3pt
 - 3.3.2. Attending an SPHC event will be worth 1pt
 - 3.3.3. Points for each class (see section 5 for Point Calculations)

4. **Horse of the Year**

- 4.1. To qualify:
 - 4.1.1. The horse must be bred/foaled in Saskatchewan
 - 4.1.2. The horse must have attended 1 event or show hosted by the SPHC
 - 4.1.3. Owner must also be a current member in good standing of the SPHC & APHA
- 4.2. Points will be calculated as follows:
 - 4.2.1. Attending an SPHC show will be worth 3 points
 - 4.2.2. Attending an SPHC non-show event will be worth 1 points
 - 4.2.3. Points for each class (see section 5 for Point Calculations)

5. **Point Calculations**

- 5.1. Points will be calculated using PAC and APHA points only. PAC points are open to all APHA horses in all disciplines (show, speed events, roping, reining, dressage, jumping, etc.). The PAC program requires a yearly enrollment with APHA. You can find how to enroll into the PAC program on the Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club website.

- 5.2. Point multipliers for show/event classes - NOTE: this does not have to be “show events” it could be roping, barrel racing, cutting, cowhorse, jumping, etc.
 - 5.2.1. PAC credits will be counted at value.
 - 5.2.2. APHA points will be counted at 2x value.
- 5.3. The points for each class and attendance points will be added together for the category total (Breeder, Sire, Horse).
