NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 4 UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED

- Saskatchewan Horse Federation sanctioned show. Please refer to SHF Rulebook for more info.
- Classes may be split or combined based on the show managements discretion.
- All riders must be in the holding area and ready to enter the ring before their class.
- Show will follow rules of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation Rulebook with the exception of:
 - **Bit rule:** our goal is for all riders to work up to riding their older horse in a shank bit and one-handed. However, for the safety of beginners and beginner youth who are just learning, we will allow the option of those participating in Small Fry classes and in the Open Novice classes to ride in a snaffle with two hands regardless of their horses' age.
- No cross entry between Walk/Trot classes and other classes, with the exception of Halter.
- **2-YO in hand classes:** no cross entry with riding classes.
- **Open Novice classes:** Rider has participated in less than 5 show. Any age of rider or horse.
- All Youth are to wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets whenever they are sitting on their horse at any time during the show day, as well as during in-hand classes. Riders of all ages must wear an approved helmet for English classes.
- Mannerly stallions may be shown by Senior exhibitors **ONLY**.
- Show management has the right to change schedules or times at their discretion. The show management has the right to prohibit any person or horse from showing and has the right to remove any person or horse from the grounds/class without being liable for compensation.
- Riders must compete in their Age Division, or Open Classes if they choose, as determined by the Year of Birth as it appears on their Birth Certificate

CAMPING RESERVATIONS

- **All camping must be pre-booked** through the entry form.
- Serviced camping fee \$35/night, limited electrical only \$25/night (only 10 spots available). Non-serviced spot may be available in a designated area on a first come, first served basis

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- The SHF strongly recommends competitors are either an SHF Individual Member, or if not from Saskatchewan an Individual Member of their Provincial sport governing body (PTSO) affiliated with Equestrian Canada, or they have their own personal liability insurance.
- only SHF nominated members will be able to acquire SHF points for the Heritage Circuit
- SQHA and SPHC members must have a membership with their provincial equine sport governing body (SHF, MHC, AEF, etc.)

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Horses may arrive starting at 1:00 pm on Friday Sept. 11. Show arena will be open from 1:00 to 4:00 pm then after 8:00pm on Friday Sept. 11.
- Stall charts will be posted in the barn and on our Facebook page.
- Early Arrivals and Late Stays: If you wish to arrive early, Sept. 10, or stay overnight, Sept. 13, you must notify us on the entry form and will be subject to Extra Night Stall fee rate. Early arrivals must supply own bedding. Late stays are responsible for cleaning their own stalls.
- **All shavings must be pre-ordered.**
- **Every horse must have a stall. No tying to trailers. Straw is not allowed at Prairieland.**
- Please indicate who you would like to stall with and we will do our best to accommodate.
- Concession will be open from 10am to 3 pm, both Saturday and Sunday.
- Dogs: All Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs or they will be asked to remove the dog from the premises.
- **PAYMENT DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.** Etransfer to info@sqha.org or cheque made out to Saskatchewan Quarter Horse Association and mailed to Box 42 Holbein, SK S0J-1G0
- **Stalls and entries are non-refundable without veterinary note or doctor's note and must be submitted to show secretary prior to start of show.**
- Coggins test NOT required.
- The Bridge City Classic is NAERIC and [Living Skies Award Circuit](#) approved.

- **In order for registration to be processed, every Horse/Rider combo needs to fill out an entry form and payment must be received in full by etransfer to info@sqha.org**
- By submitting an entry form, you consent to having your photo taken for promotional material.
- Placing under each judge with ribbons to 5th. Monetary prizes as follows:
 - 1st \$20.00, 2nd \$15.00, 3rd \$10.00, 4th 5.00 **(per judge)**
 - If a class has 3 or less riders, prize payout will be 1st \$15.00, 2nd \$10.00
- Leadline and Small Fry classes are free entry with no cash payouts. Each Small Fry must pay an office fee.

HIGH POINT AWARDS

All Around High Point, applicable divisions:

- Senior, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C, Senior Walk/Trot, Junior Walk/Trot
- Qualifying classes for All Around High Point are Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Western Pleasure, and Horsemanship (Junior High Points may be combined if divisions are combined)

Ranch High Point, Applicable divisions:

- Senior and Junior (No Reserve High Point Prizes)
- Qualifying classes are Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding, and Working Western Rail

EXTRA INCENTIVES

Yearling Trifecta

- \$60 Entry Includes All Breed Halter, All Breed Yearling Longe Line, and All Breed Yearling Trail in Hand
- \$150 added money sponsored by Colleen McMillan

Top AQHA & Top APHA Jackpot

- Pay entry fee of \$25. One jackpot per breed. Submit proof of current AQHA or APHA Membership. Submit papers for AQHA or APHA registered horse competing. Your top 3 scored classes will be used to calculate the Top AQHA and Top APHA Jackpot and Aggregate Payout Format (80% of entries)
