

Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club- 2026 Year End High Point Rules

1. Year-End High Point and Reserve High Point

1.1. To qualify:

- 1.1.1. Owner must also be a current member in good standing of the SPHC & APHA
- 1.1.2. The horse must have attended 2 events or shows hosted by the SPHC
- 1.1.3. Non-APHA sanctioned shows (open/schooling shows), will be counted as “events” towards eligibility, but will not count for points. See PAC awards for open show and event high points as well as Rider Log

2. Categories

3. Point Calculations

3.1. Points will be calculated as follows below, using **Breed-show results** only

4. PAC - Paint Alternative Competition

- 4.1. Owner and any exhibitors must be current members in good standing of APHA & SPHC
- 4.2. Horse must be enrolled in the APHA PAC program before any points will count
- 4.3. Must fill out the SPHC nomination (so we know to track you horse)
- 4.4. The owner/exhibitors must submit their records within 30 days of each event, as per APHA PAC rules

5. Rider Log

- 5.1. Owner and any exhibitors must be current members in good standing of APHA & SPHC
- 5.2. Horse must be enrolled in the APHA PAC program (includes Rider Log)
- 5.3. Must fill out the SPHC nomination (so we know to track you horse)
- 5.4. The owner/exhibitors must submit their records
