

2023 SPHC \$500.00 Youth Scholarship

Eligibility:

- Any youth from any province with a 2023 SPHC membership that owns(or parents own) or leases(valid lease agreement in 2023) an APHA horse are eligible to apply.
- To apply you must be 13 years to 18 years old as of January 1, 2023.
- Cannot have been awarded SPHC youth scholarship in the past.
- Participants must notify the committee of their intent to compete for the scholarship by June 15, 2023 via email to saskatchewanpainthorseclub@gmail.com along with a copy of your horses registration papers or valid lease agreement.

Requirements(overall scoring):

- (1)Submit letter/essay about yourself; include your involvement with horses;and why you should be awarded this scholarship(25% of overall scholarship scoring)
 - essay to be 500-800 words
 - can be handwritten or typed
 - Essay marked on basis of:
 - writing style - clear and logical format(30%)
 - Punctuation, grammar and formatting(30%)
 - content (40%)
- (2)Final grades (25% of overall scholarship scoring)
 - to be submitted to the scholarship committee of the SPHC by August 1, 2023
- (3)Extracurricular involvement and Volunteer work -(25% of overall scholarship scoring)
 - please list/summarize what you have done
- (4)Horsemanship Pattern- (25% of overall scholarship scoring)
 - You will be expected to ride a horsemanship pattern at our Bridge City show in September 2023. If you will not be able to attend please notify the committee ahead of time and a video will be allowed to be submitted instead.

Scoring:

2 SPHC directors who do not have a family member in the scholarship (or a close friendship with a scholarship participant) will calculate the results. If required, directors can request non-directors to assist with the scoring to avoid conflicts of interest.
